CHAPTER 39

1. Read 1 Corinthians 10:13 and then read Job 38 and write down any questions or insights that occur to you.
2. What animals are named in chapter 39 and what is their number?
3. What is God saying in verses 1-4?
4. What might the wild ass be representative of, or what is God saying to Job, in verses 5-8?
5. What might the wild ox be representative of, or what is God saying to Job, in verses 9 - 12?

6. What might the ostrich be representative of, or what is God saying to Job, in verses 13-18? Consider also, Isaiah 34:14, Jeremiah 50:39, and Revelation 18:2.

7. What might the horse be representative of, or what is God saying to Job, in verses 19-25?

8. What might the hawk and the eagle be representative of, or what is God saying to Job, in verses 26-30? Consider also, Exodus 19:4, Leviticus 11:13, Hosea 8:1, Jeremiah 49:16, Obadiah 1:4, and Matthew 24:27-28.
