2. Who does the first beast of chapter 13 look like and what do the heads and horns represent? Verses 1-2. See also, Revelation 12:3; Daniel 7: 1-8; 2 Thessalonians 2:3-12.

What is wrong with one of the heads of this first beast, why might this be important, and how was this done?
Verses 3-4, 12, 14. See also, Revelation 5:6; Zechariah 11:15-17.

4. What is the response of those in the world to the beast that comes out of the sea? Verse 4.

5. How long does the first beast reign and what does it do with that time? Verses 5-10.

6. Who worships the beast from the sea? Verse 8.

 What does verse 10 mean? See also, Isaiah 14:2; Matthew 7:2; Revelation 16:6.

 What is the meaning of image that the second beast portrays, from where does it come, and what is another title for it? Verses 11-17. See also, Revelation 5:6-10, 16:13, 19:20.

9. How does the second beast captivate the world and lead them astray? Verses 11-15. See also, 1 Kings 18:38; 2 Kings 1:10; Revelation 11:5.

 What is it that the second beast ultimately leads the world to do and what is its meaning? Verses 16-18. See also, Deuteronomy 6:8, Exodus 28:36-38; 1 Kings 10:16; Ezekiel 9:4; Revelation 7:3, 14:1.
