3. What are the thrones in verses 4 and whom might it be who is seated on them? See also, Matthew 19:28; Luke 22:29-30; I Corinthians 6:2.

 What is the first resurrection and what is the second resurrection? Verses 4-6, 11-15. See also, Daniel 12:2; Matthew 27:45-56; John 5:28-29; 1 Corinthians 15:20-28; 1 Thessalonians 4:13-18; 1 Peter 2:9. 5. What is the second death written of in verse 6? See also verses 11-15; Matthew 10:28.

Why do you think Satan is released as written about in verse 7 and what does he do and cause to take place?
Verses 7-15. See also, Ezekiel 38-39.

7. What is taking place in verse 11 with the sky and earth? Is it figurative or litteral?

 What are the books and which is the most important of them in verses 12-15?
