

4.	Who or what does the black horse and rider represent when they come forth at the breaking of the third seal by Christ? What might the scales represent? Verses 5-6, see also: Leviticus 26:25; Lamentations 5:10; Ezekiel 4:10-16; Zechariah 6:1-8; Matthew 24:7.
	Who or what does the pale horse and rider represent when they come fourth at the breaking of the forth seal by Christ? Verses 7-8, see also: Leviticus 26:22-33; Jeremiah 15:2-4; Ezekiel 5:15-17; Matthew 24:7-8; seRevelation 1:18.
6.	What does the breaking of the fifth seal reveal and what might the purpose of the fifth seal be? Verses 9-11, see also, Genesis 4:10-11; Exodus 29:10-12; Matthew 24:8-13.

7.	What does the breaking of the sixth seal reveal or cause and how might it relate to the breaking of the fifth seal? Verses 12-17, see also: Isaiah 13:9-10, 24:23, 60:19-20; Ezekiel 32:7-8; Zechariah 14:4-7; Joel 2:10, 30-31, 3:15; Amos 8:9; Haggai 2:6-7, 21-22; Matthew 24:29; Acts 2:19-20.
