3. Who has prepared "the holy city?" Verse 2.

4. What is the result of the coming of "the holy city?" Verses 3-8.

What is "done" in verse 6 to which the one sitting on the throne is referring? Who is sitting on the throne?
See also, Isaiah 41:4, 44:6, 48:12, 55:1; John 4:4-15; Revelation 1:8.

6. Who receives the heritage of Christ and who doesn't? Verses 7-8. See also, 1 Corinthians 6:9-10; Galatians 5:19-21; Ephesians 5:5-6.

 How is the Bride described by John and what questions does it give you or what does the Holy Spirit reveal to you about her as seen here by John? Verses 9-27.

8. Is both Jew and Gentile represented in the description of the Bride? And if so, how?

9. Why does the city have no need of the sun or moon or what might this mean in verses 22-24?

 What do we glimpse of what life might look like in the coming eternity from John's description of the holy city? Verses 24-27.
