1. Read chapter one of Romans and record any questions or thoughts that come to you as you read.
2. What does Paul praise God for in regard to the Roman Christians?
Verse 8.
3. Why does Paul wish to visit the Roman Christians?
Verses 9-15.
4. Why does Paul say he is under obligation to the Greeks and barbarians in verse 14?
See also Acts 9:16.
5. Why would Paul say that he is "not ashamed of the gospel", in other words, why would shame be an issue at all in regard to the gospel?

6. What does the phrase, "the righteousness of God," mean?
Verse 17. See also Philippians 3:9.

7. Verse 17 is a keystone to the epistle of Romans. What does, "For in it the righteousness of God is revealed from faith to faith," mean.
See also Hebrews 11:6.

8. How do the unrighteous suppress the truth?
Verse 18, 21-23.

9. How has God shown and made known Himself to man?
Verse 19-20. See also Romans 10:17-18, Galatians 3:18-19, Psalms 19:1-6.

10. What is the result of man suppressing the truth of God?
Verses 24-32. See also Romans 6:23.
