4. What is Paul talking about when he says we have "obtained access by faith"? access to what?  
Verse 2. See also John 14:6; Ephesians 2:18; Hebrews 10:19-20; Psalm 16:9-10; Revelation 3:23.
5. How is it that Paul claims we can rejoice in our sufferings - our tribulations?  
Verses 3-5. See also, Matthew 5:10-12; Acts 5:32; 2 Corinthians 12:9-10; James 1:2-3; Hebrews 12:10-11.
