8.	What does it mean that the "regular burnt offering was taken away from him, and the place of his sanctuary was overthrown (ESV)," in verse 11 and echoed in verse 12?
9.	If the vision Daniel received was of these past kings as noted in questions three through six, how can Gabriel say, "that the vision is for the time of the end (ESV)," in verse 17?
10.	Who are the "transgressors" in verse 23?
11.	What was Daniels reaction to this horrible vision of the future and is there anything we can learn from him in it? Verse 27.
